Humane Society Award

Acting on observations from a routine offender contact that suggested participation in dog fighting, Agent McMonagle and the Pennsylvania State Police assisted the Chester County Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Humane Enforcement Officers with a search of an offender's home last October. Significant evidence of dog fighting training was found, such as large dog treadmills, anabolic steroid injectable liquids, syringes and dogfighting propaganda. In addition, ammunition, a pistol magazine, and a 1KG package of cocaine was seized. The offender and his girlfriend were charged under a new law passed in September that makes it illegal to possess animal fighting paraphernalia. In fact, this was the first known instance of its use in the state. Five adult pit bull terriers and seven puppies were rescued and sent to the Chester County SPCA.
