### **Chairman Green and Board Member Tuttle Recognized for Service**

At the March 14 monthly Board Meeting, Chairman Michael Green and Board Member John Tuttle were honored upon their retirement after serving a combined 76 years of public service.

Chairman Green was presented with a plaque “in recognition of dedicated service” to the Board and the Commonwealth and a proclamation from the state House and Senate, which recognized his “more than 40 years of distinguished service in community corrections, probation and parole and court administration.”

Mr. Green was first confirmed as a Board Member in 2003 and reconfirmed in 2009. He was acting chairman from September 2004 to June 2005 and chairman since October 2015. Prior to his time with the Board, he was the Chief Probation Officer for Mercer County, NJ, and First Deputy Chief Probation Officer and probation officer in Philadelphia.

Board Member Tuttle was also presented with a plaque for his “commitment to excellence and visionary leadership” in advancing the mission of the Board and dedicated service to the Commonwealth as well as a state House and Senate proclamation, which stated “Mr. Tuttle has striven to adhere to the highest standards of service and “earned the respect and admiration” of friends and colleagues.

Mr. Tuttle was first confirmed as a Board Member in 2009 and was acting chairman from December 2014 to October 2015. Prior to his appointment on the Board, he served as the Deputy Executive Director, the director of the Office of Probation and Parole Services, and Central Region Director.

Prior to his appointment to the Board, Mr. Tuttle served for 22 years in the York County Adult Probation and Parole Department, becoming the Chief Adult Probation Officer in 1997.
