

GREENE COUNTY

The Department provides the following programs and specialized services:

- **House Arrest/Global Positioning System** – This Program is comprised of offenders eligible for Restrictive Intermediate Punishment and any other offenses ordered by the Court. The Program consists of home confinement, with approved “windows” for offenders to work and attend treatment or school.
- **Mental Illness-Substance Abuse (MISA) Program** – The Department participates in an inter-agency collaborative effort between the Greene County Court of Common Pleas and area social service agencies. The agencies work with offenders to remove barriers to their successful reentry to society. Candidates must be currently participating in drug and alcohol and/or mental health counseling to participate in this Program.
- **Forensic Re-Entry Court** – An Intensive Supervision and Treatment Team (ISTT) has been established to maintain the offender in the community, and assist and monitor his compliance with needed services in the least restrictive setting that is safely possible. The core team consists of the offender, an assigned probation officer, the Forensic Reentry Specialist, and any relevant service provider or peer support. Additionally, the offender’s case is reviewed regularly by the sentencing Judge either through a formal appearance by the offender before the Judge in the setting of the courtroom or by attendance of the Judge at an ISTT meeting. Other ISTT offenders may be at the meeting. At these meetings, the offenders are required to account for their behavior and progress. Technical violations will result in graduated sanctions. Offenders that are compliant and demonstrating progress will receive accolades and incentives from the Court.
